We are ready for a new term and new exciting topics. In English we are going to start the term writing and performing poetry. In maths we will start the term developing our multiplication and division skills before moving onto fractions. Please encourage children to continue to practise their times tables, instant recall targets and telling the time. Investigating magnets and forces will be our next focus in science. The initial PE sessions will include archery and gymnastics.

Homework will continue to be sent out every half term and children will get the opportunity to share their work with their peers on the last week of each half term.
