I Must.....

Read my reading book **every** night and try to read a broad range of fiction, non-fiction and poetry.

Write a book recommendation on each book I read and bring it into class.

Practise weekly spellings and words from the Y5/6 statutory words list using strategies taught in class. Look up the meanings of the words and write a sentence using them.

Practise all of my times tables/division facts and written methods of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

Practise any SATs papers that are sent home and bring back into class for revision. Revise Maths covered so far this year **(Y6 only)**.



I can also.....

Research J.R.R. Tolkien, author of 'The Hobbit', and write a short biography about him. This could be presented in the form of a booklet, power-point or journalistic article.

Write a biographical newspaper article about an idol of your choice e.g. a sporting idol like Usain Bolt, Andy Murray etc, a famous author, an actor/actress, someone in the local community who you admire. Alternatively, this could be based on a fictional character.

Sketch a piece of Roman architecture e.g. columns, aqueducts, public baths etc. Add tone to this using any medium e.g. lead pencil, black wax crayon & ink wash, poster paint, pastels, watercolours.

Can you bake/cook a Roman dish.

Research & present the changes that the Romans made to British architecture e.g. roads, aqueducts. Can you build a model of one of these pieces of architecture?

Research the Roman army. Can you make a shield or helmet that a Roman soldier would have worn?

Create your own fictional superhero and write a character description of them. You may want a drawing to accompany this.
