Practise my reading, saying and spelling my wordlist **to help me recognise and spell the sounds.**

Learn to **spell and read** the words on my CEW list (Common Exception Words list)

Count in **2s, 5s and 10s** within 100.

Add and subtract numbers **to 20**

e.g. $12 + 6 =$
 $19 - 11 =$

Investigate **fact families for addition and subtraction** calculations to 20.

e.g.
 $12 + 4 = 16$
 $4 + 12 = 16$
 $16 - 12 = 4$
 $16 - 4 = 12$

Can you write a recipe for a magical, mystical potion?



Can you follow some instructions? This could be to play a game, follow a recipe or draw a picture. Which words told you what to do? How did you know what order to do them in?



Can you make a game that helps you count in 2s, 5s or 10s?
