### I Must.....

Read my reading book **every** night – this does not have to be the whole book!

Practise my reading, saying and spelling my wordlist **to help me recognise and spell the sounds.**

Learn to spell and read the words on my CEW list (Common Exception Words list)

Read and write numbers from 1 to 20 in **numerals and words.**

Count to & across 100, **forwards & backwards from any number.**

Practise writing **numerals 0-9** the correct way round.

### I can also.....

Can you make a dragon puppets? This could be a sock puppet or a spoon puppet.



Can you make a dragon biscuit or a castle cake?



Can you find different materials to make a collage of a dragon, castle or knight? What adjectives would you use to describe it?



Can you design a shield? Think of what symbols you would like to put on it. You could draw them or paint them.



Can you play a game that helps you practise your tricky words? Could this be bingo or a boardgame?



Can you write your full name in different ways? Remember names need a capital letter.

Can you make a 3D castle or dragon? You could use boxes or modelling clay.



Can you create a number line from 0-10 using different items to show the number? E.g. 1 piece of pasta, 2 small stones. You could take a photo of it.
