### Safety – Thank you!

At the time of writing, we are in the incredibly fortunate position of having had no bubble isolations at school. **We are hugely grateful for your support in adhering to our safety measures.** Continued high attendance at school has given the children the best possible chance to make progress this year. It remains possible that you could be contacted by school about a case in the first few days of the holiday, but this aside, we are expecting to return to normal arrangements in September.

**Please be aware that circumstances could change over the summer,** but currently you should assume that no staggered starts will be needed in September and that you will be able to bring your child into the playground before school for an 8.45am start and 3pm finish (the same as pre-COVID arrangements). I will write to you in the week before we return to school to confirm this and to remind you about how arrangements will work.

### Uniform

After relaxing uniform expectations in light of our recent circumstances, we will be tightening up from September, now that it is easier to purchase uniform again. If you are buying uniform over the summer, please bear the following in mind:

- Every child **must** have a pair of black pumps for indoor wear and indoor PE
- Any trousers or shorts (for boys or girls) must be grey, rather than black – leggings are not permitted
- Polo shirts must be white or red; shirts must be white
- For PE all children must have a pair of black shorts and a red t-shirt (a number of children have started wearing football shirts for PE – this is not permitted. T-shirts should be plain red or red with the school logo only please)
- Only stud earrings should be worn and these should be removed for PE. **Other than watches, no other jewellery is permitted in school**

Please don't forget to label all new uniform as we still manage to generate hundreds of pounds worth of lost property over the year! If you have any other questions on uniform, please don't hesitate to contact myself, Mrs Shaw or Mrs Stylin in September.
