### History in Action!

Snowy Owls have been exploring their World War One topic with some great hands-on 'trench-building' and exploring kit bag artefacts from a real WW1 soldier.

Miss Middlebrook writes: *The children learned about the conditions of the trenches and trench warfare in WW1 through looking at different historical sources such as photographs and first-hand diary accounts. They then worked in teams to design their own trenches, then constructed British and German trenches at opposite ends of the school field using a variety of resources such as tables, chairs, skipping ropes as barbed wire and glue-stick grenades! The children re-enacted 'going over the top' into No Mans' Land, before beginning to write some vivid diary entries describing their experiences as WW1 soldiers.*
