Learning Overview;

Literacy – Innovate/Hot Task – This week we will be continuing our Shared Writing in which we will be innovating our model text ‘A Harvest to remember’. The children will then write their own story set in a place that they have been as the ‘Hot task’, implementing the techniques that they have been taught and acting on their feedback from the Cold Task and Innovate.
