Learning Overview;

Literacy – This week we will be reading Chapter 4 of ‘Omar’s Farm’, the new Guided Reading text, and completing writing activities linked to this. The children will also be completing the Hot Task of writing their own poem that conveys an image of the Rainforest to end our Topic.
