Learning Overview;

Literacy – Innovate (Shared Writing) & Hot Task – This week we will be continuing to innovate the model text through the Shared Writing of a new poem about Bonfire Night. The children will then plan and write their own poem to create an image of the rainforest as the Hot Task.

Spellings – We will be working on how to spell tricky words. Please can you help your child to learn and use these spellings (Word List 8 on Spellodrome). Spelling Journals will be sent home for the children to practise their spellings and sentences in. Please can these be brought back into school on a Wednesday for our Spelling lesson.

Maths - This week we will be finishing our unit on methods of addition and subtraction, then beginning our unit on Multiplication and Division by looking at multiplying by 6 and 7. Please can you practise times tables, with a particular focus on the 6 and 7 multiplication facts.

Topic – We will be continuing our Topic ‘Why should the rainforest be important to us all?’ by learning about the work of Henri Rousseau and sketching rainforest animals. We will also be doing more Rainmaker rehearsals through the course of the week.
