Learning Overview;

Literacy – This week we will be reading Chapter 2 of ‘Omar’s Farm’, the new Guided Reading text, and completing writing activities linked to this.

Spellings – The children will be assessed on these in their Wednesday lesson as we missed Spelling last week due to the NFU Roadshow visit. Please can you help your child to learn and use these spellings (Word List 8 on Spellodrome). Spelling Journals were sent home last week for the children to practise their spellings and sentences in.

Maths - This week we will be continuing with our unit on Multiplication and Division by looking at multiplying by 7 and 9. Please can you practise times tables, with a particular focus on the 7, 9, 11 and 12 multiplication facts.

Topic – We will be continuing our Topic ‘Why should the rainforest be important to us all?’ by continuing to develop our sketches of rainforest animals in different mediums and learning about rainforest plants/how to classify them.
