Whole School Theme - Let's Explore the World

Our theme in Geography is Maps. During the topic we will be learning about Longitude & Latitude, Hemispheres & Time Zones, how to read a map and mapping the world. Our theme of Maps will be integrated across a range of other subjects this half term.

In Guided Reading we will be reading 'The Explorer' by Katherine Rundell. In Maths, we will be finishing off long multiplication and division before we start Decimals & Percentages which will include ordering, comparing and rounding decimals to the nearest whole number.

Our Science topic for this half term is Living Things & their Habitats, in which we will be observing over time in order to learn about the life cycles of mammals, amphibians, insects & birds. We will also be looking at reproduction in animals and plants.

In P.E. we will be doing athletics. In R.E. we will be exploring the question 'What did Jesus do to save human beings?' and in Computing, the children will be learning about data, databases and information. During our PSHE lessons this term we will be learning about how to stay healthy, whilst in Art we will be looking at Erte's Art Deco designs.

Y5 will also be having Music lessons with an external teacher on Thursday afternoons. Y5 P.E. lesson will also be on Thursday afternoons, so **children are required to come into school in P.E. kit on Thursdays please.**
