#### Whole School Theme - Adventures in Time

This half term we will be exploring our new Geography theme of Settlements, during this topic we will be learning about the British Isles, Counties and Cities and different types of settlements. Our theme of Settlements will be integrated in cross-curricular links across a range of other subjects this half term.

In Guided Reading we will be reading 'Why the Whales Came' by Michael Morpurgo. In Maths we will be looking at Multiplication & Division, where we will be looking at multiples of 3, multiplying and dividing by 6 & 9 and looking at the 7, 11 & 12 times tables. For our science topic this half term, the children will be learning about Habitats.

In P.E. we will be doing dance this half term, so the children are expected to come in P.E. kit on Wednesdays. They must also come to school in trainers on Tuesdays, for our extra period of weekly P.E. In R.E. we will be exploring the question, "What is the Trinity?" Finally, in Computing, the children will be learning about creating media and audio editing.

During our PSHE lessons this half term, we will be learning about Celebrating our Differences. In Art, the children will be using Water Colours to show impressionism, inspired by Monet and his 'Lily Pads'. Y4 will also be having Music lessons, where they will be looking at percussion influenced by the sounds of the rainforest.
