#### World Mental Health Day – Thursday 10 October



We used World Mental Health Day this week to practice our 'Tools to get in the Green Zone'. The children identify and respond to their emotions through emotional check-ins every day in school as part of our Relational Approach to Behaviour. We have been building a bank of 'tools' to help ourselves get into the 'green zone' – ready for learning, when we may be feeling dysregulated or 'fizzy'.

We have worked on the 'body scan' this week as well as 'five star/five finger breathing' and even wall pushups (see below). The children are getting better and better at knowing which strategies work for them. We also teach areas of mindfulness and mental health weekly as part of our Jigsaw PSHE learning and through our Collective Worships. We often do Five Finger Breathing to calm and regulate ourselves in whole-school Worship. If you're interested in using this at home, we have used this clip in school:
