End of Year Results:

At this point in the year, we get our results for national assessments in the Early Years, Yr1 Phonics and Year Six SATs.

In Little Owls, 71% of children achieved a **Good Level of Development (GLD)** compared to a 2024 national figure of 67.7%. In Elf Owls, 76% of children passed the **Yr1 phonics screening**, compared to a national figure of 80.2% in 2024.

In Year 6, provisional figures show that 85% of Hambleton children achieved at least the expected standard in **reading** (compared to a 2025 national figure of 75%). In **writing**, 92% of Hambleton children achieved at least the expected standard (compared to 72% nationally). In **maths**, 96% of Hambleton children achieved at least the expected standard (compared to 74% nationally). In **English grammar**, **punctuation & spelling**, 96% of Hambleton children achieved at least the expected standard (compared to 73% nationally).

In **reading** 38% of Hambleton Y6 children achieved Greater Depth standard, and in **English grammar, punctuation & spelling** 35% of Hambleton Y6 children achieved Greater Depth Standard. In **Maths**, 31% of Hambleton children achieved Greater Depth standard and 12% achieved this Greater Depth standard in **writing**. The above figures are provisional and there is no Greater Depth national comparison data available from the DFE.

I would like to extend my heartfelt congratulations to all our pupils and our Year 6 pupils on their outstanding SATs results. Thank you to all parents, carers and staff for the unwavering support you have given each and every child throughout their time at Hambleton. Your encouragement and dedication have played a key role in helping them achieve such superb outcomes.
