New Online Payment System

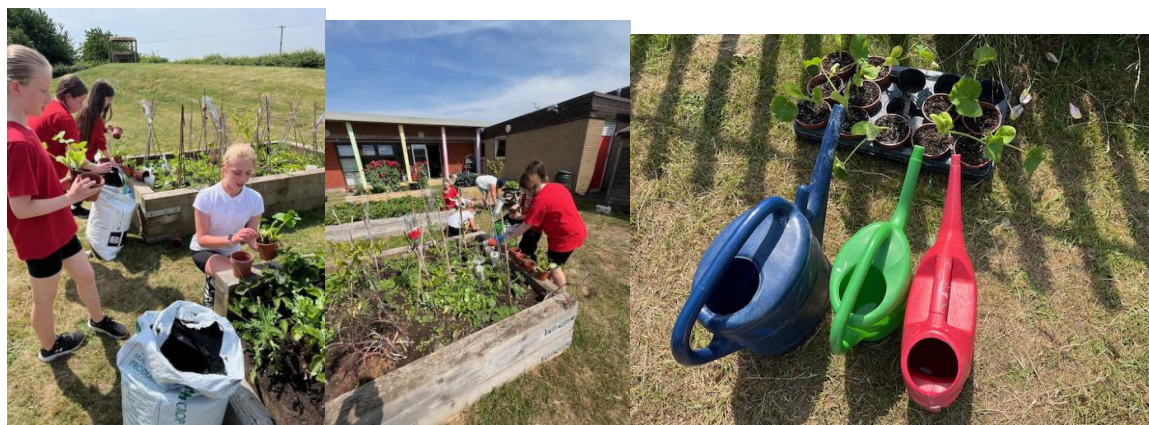
From September, we expect to be using a new online payment system called ARBOR. This will be used instead of ParentPay.
