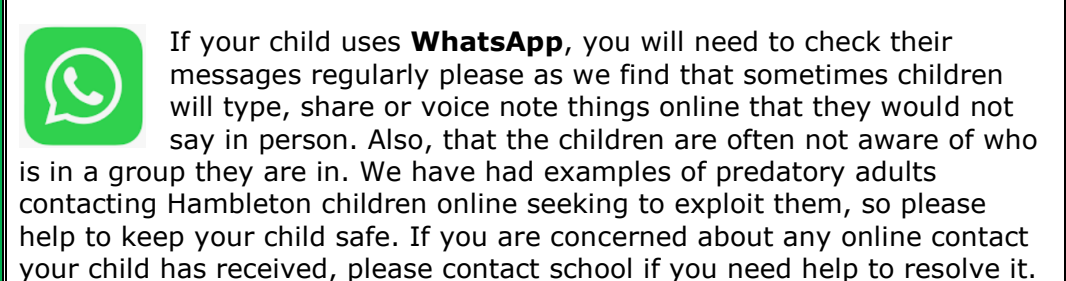
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### **Safeguarding**

From talking to the children, we know that many children received new devices for Christmas and that you may be grappling to understand complicated parent controls for their new devices and games. As ever, our advice is that any internet use should be in a 'public area' (e.g. kitchen or lounge rather than alone in their bedrooms) and that you talk often, calmly and in a blame-free manner with your child about any internet use.

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 If your child uses **WhatsApp**, you will need to check their messages regularly please as we find that sometimes children will type, share or voice note things online that they would not say in person. Also, that the children are often not aware of who is in a group they are in. We have had examples of predatory adults contacting Hambleton children online seeking to exploit them, so please help to keep your child safe. If you are concerned about any online contact your child has received, please contact school if you need help to resolve it.
