

Intent:

At Hambleton CE Primary School, the intent of our PSHE curriculum is to deliver a curriculum which is accessible to all, and that will maximise the outcomes for every child. PSHE is embedded in all that we do to enable our children to become independent, responsible, healthy and confident members of society. Our PSHE curriculum aims to support the development of the ‘whole child’, by helping them to understand how they are developing personally and socially as well as promoting their social, mental and physical development.

We intend for children to:

- Develop their sense of self-worth, their self-knowledge, self-esteem and self-confidence.
- Feel confident to play an active, positive role within the school and wider community.
- Know how to keep themselves and other safe, both physically and emotionally.
- Learn valuable life skills that will help them access the wider curriculum and give them a firm basis for adulthood.
- Understand their rights and responsibilities, including their part to play as a member of a diverse society.

Implementation:

PSHE is taught through discrete lessons and is also distributed throughout our wider curriculum. Some examples of this include:

- Healthy lifestyles through P.E. and D.T. lessons
- Online health and wellbeing through Computing lessons
- Diverse societies through Religious Education, Music, and History lessons

Our school follows the Jigsaw PSHE scheme of learning, and is reviewed often to ensure that it is relevant, up to date and appropriate.

British Values are a key part of PSHE learning, and are integrated throughout the PSHE curriculum as well as during whole-school events.

Our PSHE curriculum is also designed to take national events into consideration, for example through Anti-Bullying week, Internet Safety day, and Mental Health Week.

Impact:

By the end of each key stage, children will have had the opportunities to meet the end of key stage statements in line with the statutory guidance outlined in the Relationships Education, Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) and Health Education.

Our curriculum, along with various trips, workshops and visitors, will impact our children by enabling them to make outstanding progress throughout their time at Hambleton.

We will have developed considerate citizens and our children will understand how to keep themselves and others safe in our ever changing world.

Our children will understand that they have the capability to change the world and the importance of their actions. This will all be evidenced through pupil voice and within their Whole Class Jigsaw PSHE book.
