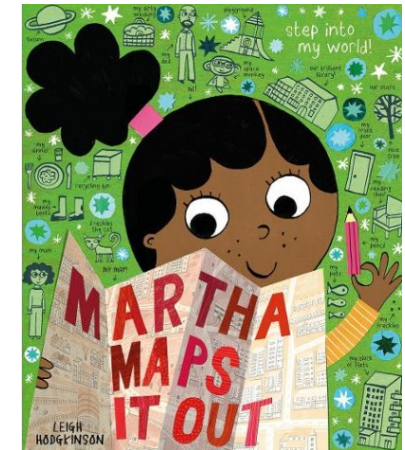
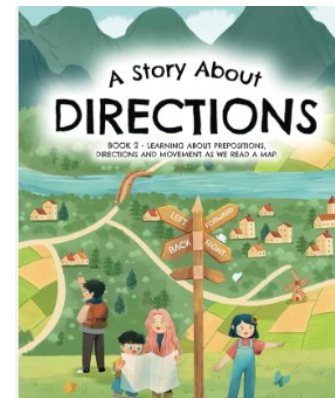
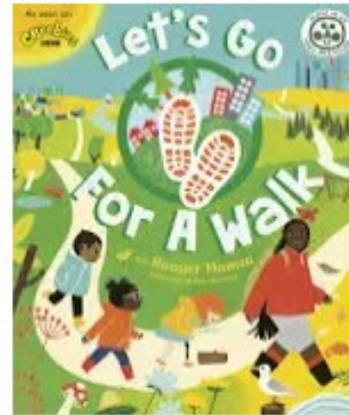


Year One – Our Local Area Knowledge Bank
