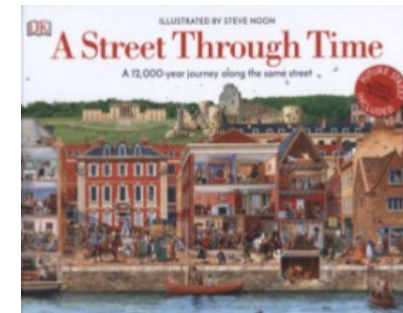
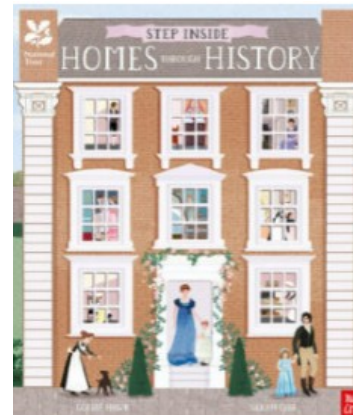


Settlements

Vocabulary	Definition
agriculture	The farming of crops or animals.
early settlers	The first people to settle in an area including Romans, Vikings and Anglo-Saxons.
health care	Includes, doctors, dentists, hospitals etc.
industrial	Businesses that provide products or services.
residential	Somewhere designed for people to live in.
leisure	Time spent away from work relaxing.
retail	Shops selling products to people



Knowledge Bank (Year 4)

Settlements:

- A settlement is a town, village or city where people live.
- Many settlements have existed for 100 or 1000s of years
- Early settlers in UK were Romans Vikings and Anglo Saxons eg. London Ad 43.
- Settlements develop in certain locations. To know major settlements are near water as early settlers needed shelter, water and food.
- By and Thorpe are Viking place names. Ham (village), ford (river crossing), Ton (farm) is Anglo Saxon and Cester/caster (Castle) is Roman.
- Villages are more agricultural areas and cities tend to have more leisure and industry
